### Admission Requirements

**Deadline: March 1**

- Minimum of a 20 on the ACT or a 950 on the SAT (combined math and critical reading score)
- Minimum of a 2.25 high school GPA
- Minimum of 17 academic classes:
  - 4 English
  - 3 Math (Algebra I and higher)
  - 3 Science (including 2 lab sciences)
  - 3 Social Science
  - 1 Foreign Language
  - 3 additional academic courses

**Deadline: December 1**

Students who wish to be considered for academic scholarships should be admitted to UAB by the **Priority Admission date of Dec. 1<sup>st</sup>**.

**Blazer Achievement Scholarship** (26+ ACT, 3.0+ GPA)

\$3,500

**Blazer Pride Scholarship** (24+ ACT, 3.0+ GPA)

\$2,500

*NOTE: Students receiving UAB merit based scholarships are required to live on campus for their first year of enrollment. All scholarships are renewable for 4 years.*
